

ARCHBISHOP'S MESSAGE



COMMUNIO INDIA

1. Communio India:

Many of us know about the MISSIO in some European countries, such as Germany, Austria, Belgium, which raises funds from the Catholics of their countries to help the pastoral, missionary activities of the Dioceses in the mission countries of Asia, Africa and Latin-America. We have received much financial help from Missio, Germany and from other countries for our pastoral and evangelization activities. We are grateful to them.

After some years of prayer and reflections, the Conference of the Catholic Bishops of India (CCBI) has decided to create an institution called **COMMUNIO INDIA** with similar objectives of Missio. Communio India aims of raising funds from the faithful of India, to help poor Dioceses and poor Religious

Congregations for pastoral and evangelization works. This fund will be administrated by a special Committee constituted by the CCBI.

The First Sunday of Advent (2nd December, 2018), the Sunday close to the feast of St. Francis Xavier, the patron of Missions, is established as the Communio India Sunday. Like Mission Sunday, we are invited and exhorted to celebrate this Communio India Sunday with special prayer and collections, to help the poor Latin Rite Dioceses in India. At present there are 132 Latin Rite Dioceses in India. Parish Priests are kindly requested to take the Communio India Sunday Collection on Sunday, 2nd December 2018 and send it to the Procure Office before 31st December 2018. The Procurator will send this collection to the Communio India Office in CCBI Centre, Bangalore.

N.B.: The circular letter of Cardinal Oswald Gracious, the President of CCBI about Communio India is given in this News Letter.

2. Dalit Liberation Sunday

Sunday, 11th November 2018 is celebrated as Dalit Liberation Sunday this year. The theme is: "As for me and my household, we will serve the Lord" (Joshua 24:15). On this day let us all pray in a special way that our Dalit brothers and sisters, that our Dalit Muslim brothers and sisters be constitutionally granted Scheduled Caste Status.

3. Rev. Fr. J. Dussaigne, MEP (1927 - 2018):

Rev. Fr. J. Dussaigne, MEP came to our Archdiocese as a missionary in 1952. He was a dedicated pastor of souls. He worked as parish priest in Sathiamangalam, Vridhachalam, Villianur, Kurumbagaram and Notre Dame des Anges. He was the last MEP Parish Priest of N. D. Des Anges for a long period of 24 years. He promoted catechetical ministry in all these parishes. He welcomed priests cordially and built up good relationships among the members of our Archdiocesan presbyterium. He was a man of faith and prayer, of hard work and discipline. His life was a source of inspiration and encouragement to our faithful, religious and priests.

In 2007 he returned to France. He continued his pastoral services to the Indian Tamil Catholics in France. He spent his last days at the MEP Retired Priests Home at Lauris. He died on 15th October at the age of 92. We thank God for the precious gift of Rev. Fr. J. Dussaigne, M.E.P. to our Archdiocese and pray for the repose of his souls.

4. A Kind Reminder:

Communio India Sunday

Sunday, 2 December, 2018 (First Sunday of Advent) "Love one another as I have loved you" (John 13:34)

To All Archbishops, Bishops, Priests, Deacons, Religious, Catechists and Lay Faithful of the Latin Catholic Church in India

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Jesus Christ,

Today we begin a new liturgical year with the season of Advent which offers us a sense of hope, joy and encouragement as we continue our journey of faith to celebrate the Mystery of the Incarnation. Advent refers not only to the birth of our Lord at his First Coming but also to our hope and expectation of him at his Second Coming. This expectation demands from us fidelity to the Gospel by being constantly watchful like the wise virgins (cf. Mt. 25: 1-13) or the ever faithful and wise servant (cf. Mt. 24:45-51) for the Master's return.

Incarnation is an intimate expression of God's unconditional love for us: "God so loved the world, that he gave His only Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life" (Jn. 3:16). Christ has taught and shown us that Love is the heart of the Gospel. To receive God's salvation is to be fully taken up in this infinite love of God for us in Jesus Christ.

During this Advent and Christmas season we are called to share God's love with our fellow brothers and sisters, especially with the poor and the needy. Heeding the call of Our Lord Jesus Christ, we have to live our lives for others. This can happen through a *conversion of heart* that Jesus called us to, at the very beginning of his ministry. He invites us to make a new and determined effort to fulfil our responsibilities as disciples of Christ, in order to live fully the two great commandments, to love God with our whole heart, soul and mind, and to love our neighbour as ourselves (cf. Mt 22: 36-40).

Pope Francis says: "Whenever our interior life becomes caught up in its own interests and concerns, there is no longer room for others, no place for the poor" (*EvangeliiGaudium* 2).

Many Christians live in poor and even inhuman conditions, deprived of the basic necessities of life such as drinking water, food, clothing, shelter, education, employment, and a secure future. Those among us whom God has blessed with sufficient material means to meet our needs have the responsibility to reach out to our poor brothers and sisters and provide them with pastoral assistance, both spiritual and material. There are local Churches in our country struggling to live their Christian faith in the midst of socio-economic backwardness.

A good number of Catholics in India do not have a proper place to worship and celebrate the Holy Eucharist together. Many of our missionaries in rural and remote areas are working with limited facilities. They need financial assistance to build places of worship and other minimum facilities for their communities.

As you are well aware the Conference of Catholic Bishops of India (CCBI) has been dreaming and discussing for a long time about the possibility of initiating a funding agency on the pattern of *Missio* in Germany to assist our mission dioceses, which are facing financial difficulties, for their pastoral and evangelical work. This would be a concrete expression of our solidarity with one another in following the example of the early Church that was filled with the power of the Holy Spirit.

After extensive discussions and deliberations through various meetings, the CCBI has established, *Communio India* to assist our dioceses and religious congregations working in the missions.

The purposes of *Communio India* are (1) to build a culture of sharing in order to express solidarity with our needy brothers and sisters in the country. (2) to encourage our faithful to pray and help the missions and the missionaries and to promote missionary vocations. (3) to inspire our lay faithful to work in mission areas as lay missionaries.

It is our responsibility to promote *Communio India* as a means of evangelization: "The Church on earth is by its very nature missionary since according to the plan of God the Father, it has its origin in the mission of the Son and the Holy Spirit" (*Ad Gentes*, 2). It is the duty of the Church to encourage the Christian faithful to embark upon the mission

of evangelization marked with the Joy of the Gospel (Cf. EvangeliiGaudium, 1).

It is our earnest desire that Communio India Sunday should be observed faithfully and meaningfully in all our parishes and institutions. Holy Mass ought to be solemnly celebrated and special prayers must be added for the Church's mission and her missionaries. It should not only be a day of prayer but also a day of awareness to enable us to become missionary disciples. We request you to encourage our missionaries not only through prayers but also through your generous contributions.

We appeal to all the faithful to be generous in sharing their resources to help our brothers and sisters in need in the remote regions of the Indian Church. All our contributions, big or small, would be of great help for the missionary work of the Church in India.

As we open our arms and hearts to celebrate Baby Jesus, at His nativity, we are inspired to open our arms and hearts also to those who are in need of us. Sharing is the most relevant and meaningful way to celebrate God's generous gift of His divine life with us in the manger of Bethlehem.

The Church in India is blessed with numerous, dedicated and committed missionaries. We appreciate and acknowledge their sacrifice and passion for missionary work. We request all of you to continuously pray for our missionaries and the missions. May Jesus the Good Shepherd guide and help us to carry out His work of evangelisation through Communio India.

Highlights & Report of the Canon Law Society of India (22-

26, Oct.2018)

On 22-26, October, 2018, out of 158 registered 149 CLSI members from India attended the 32nd Annual Conference at Dharamaram Vidya Kshetram, Bengaluru-560 029 (Institute of Oriental Canon Law, Research Centre, DVK – Auditorium). The Conference concentrated on the main theme on the "Laity in the Mission of the Church." On the first day, at 4.00 pm., in the presence of Most Rev. Dr. Peter Machado, the Archbishop of Bangalore and Most Rev. Dr. Antony Kariyil, CMI, Bishop of Mandya inaugurated the XXXII Annual Conference.

In his inaugural address the Archbishop spoke about the challenges that the Church is facing today from Canonical perspective. Bishop Antony Kariyil pointed out the challenges from sociological perspective. Both of them were out spoken over the anti-legalism, anti-clericalism, media projection, etc. Sr. Licia, SMI highlighted on "Empowering Women in the Church" and focused on the role of women in the mission of Church.

On 23rd Oct., Bishop Antony Kariyil, CMI presided over The Holy Qurbana (Syro-Malabar Rite). Dr. Prof. A. Pushparajan gave the keynote address on the main theme. Fr. Dr. Sebastian Payappilly CMI stressed that all are equal after Vatican II, The Pastoral care of couples in difficult marriage situations in the light of Chapter 8 of Amoris Laetitia. The evening hours were covered by the Honorable Justice Michael D.Cunha addressed on two topics: POCSO Act 2012 and the sexual harassment of women Act. He gave detailed information about both Acts in civil, criminal, constitutional law and Indian Penal Code. Bishop Antony Paul Mullassery, Quilon celebrated the Holy Mass on 24th Oct., Dr. Fr. Sebastian Karambai, speaking on the "Participation of the Laity in the Decision-making structures of the Local Church – some reflections", enumerated two practical examples from the parish context, whether to have parish pastoral council including the women, youth, etc. Three lay people from Bangalore spoke on the role of the laity in the participatory structures in the Penal discussion. The laity expects holiness from the clergy and religious. The laity is sanctified by the clergy. Identity of the laity is to be recognized. The reporting of the tribunal regional wise and short presentation of the doctoral students and their admission in CLSI were scheduled. Dr. Fr. Ludovic Danto, Dean from Catholic University of Paris, Faculty of Canon Law addressed on "Amoris Laetitia: Canonical Perspectives

on Irregular Unions and Other Situations" in Italian and translated in English by Fr. Romero, one of the participants. On 24th Evening, we had the Rosary Procession together before supper.

On 25th Oct., Fr. Dr. Victor George D'Souza presenting on the "Rights and Duties of Laity: Present Reality and Future prospects", stressed on the importance of the attitudinal change, verbal change, participation of laity in the power of governance, etc. Five of the experts from the participants clarified the doubts and the question hour was over before the lunch. Christ University Campus in Kengeri runs by CMI Fathers, visited by the participants and supper served by them. On 26th Oct., the service team celebrated the Mass and prayed for the deceased members of CSLI. Dr. Fr. A. Rayappan presented on the "Involvement of Laity in the Teaching Office of the Church" He stressed that the laity have disparate and distinct power in the teaching office of the Church. The whole church participates in the teaching mission of the church, so it's not only the clergy but also the laity.

Four Canonists participated from the Archdiocese of Pondicherry & Cuddalore and it is a refresher course from time to time on an Annual basis covering relevant topics from Canon Law and the Magisterium of the Church. We sincerely thank the Archbishop and the Procurator for making the necessary arrangements and meeting the expenses.

Diocesan Pastoral Council: The new Diocesan Pastoral Council (DPC) is formed and had its First Meeting on 27th October 2018 Saturday in our Pastoral Centre. Our Archbishop Presided over and the Episcopal Vicar gave the input session on the "Synod 2019 of

Pondicherry" and our Vicar General moderated the discussions. And New the Secretary Mr. Virthus Raj from Mugaiyur and Assistant Secretary Ms. Arokia Mary were elected by secret ballots. We congratulate the new members of the Diocesan Pastoral Council and the office bearers and encourage them to get involved in the common concerns of our Archdiocese.

CDPI (Conference of the Diocesan Priests of India): The Executive meeting of the CDPI was held in Warangul (Telungana) in the Bishop's House. As the National President, I participated. We evaluated the last CDPI National Council meeting held at Joe Beach, Chennai and we planned to have the next year's meeting in Jalandar, Punjab in the last week of February on the theme "Pastoral Ministry of the Diocesan Priests".

Senate Meeting: The Third Senate meeting of this year will be held on 24th November 2018, Saturday. Kindly give your suggestions to your Vicars Forane in the vicariate meetings. And I request the vicars forane to conduct the meeting, collect and send me the suggestions as early as possible.

Synod 2019 of Pondicherry: Last month we had the Core Group meeting of the Synod and regrouped the topics. And in the Commission Secretaries' meeting we have allotted the Topics to the relevant commissions and have asked them to prepare the Questionnaire. And we will be having one more core group meeting by the IInd week of November and on $22^{\rm nd}$ October we will have our Steering Committee meeting. In that meeting we will discuss about the Questionnaire and finalise them and start to print and send them to the parishes.

Evangelization Commission: Last month Rev. Fr. Bernardshaw a Capuchin Priest was invited to conduct the 3rd Saturday Prayer meeting but at the last moment, he met with an accident and broke his hand and so we invited Rev. Fr. Maria Antony, a Servite Priest from Siluvaipuram Parish of the Diocese of Thanjavur who came and gave a very nice Prayer sessions and conducted healing prayers.

This month a well known preacher, Rev. Fr. Gerald Majella, the Founder of "Jesus Heals Missionary" and the Parish Priest of Minjur, from the Archdiocese of Madras-Mylapore will conduct the meeting. Doctor's Message - What is Dengue?

Dengue is a fever due to virus spread to humans by Ade's mosquito bite (Day time biter - Morning to Evening) What are the symptoms of Dengue fever? Dengue presents as High grade fever 103, with Headach, rashes, bleeds, vomiting pain in the eyes, abdomen, joints and muscles as severe bodyache,

What are the danger signs requiring admission in hospital? Patient may require hospitalization in case of Persistent vomiting severe stomach pain, cold/red palms & soles, drowsiness / refusal of feeds, bleeds/bruises/Malèna, No Urine output for more than 6hrs.

All these Appears only when fever goes away from 5th day to next 48 Hrs, This s *Critical Phase* of Dengue fever. Needs close Monitoring when FEVER goes away... When to do tests?

What tests are to be done? First 3 days of fever please do CBC, Most important to watch is Platelets count, Packed cell volume(PCV) and NS1Dengue Antigen and Only after 5 days of fever Do Elisa DENGUE Serology test.

What is the treatment for Dengue fever?

Treatment for Dengue fever is only supportive since antiviral drugs against Dengue virus isn't discovered yet... But taking care of Dehydration status & Close monitoring is mandatory, So Monitor the fluid intake and urine output once in 2to4 hours.

The patient should take adequate fluids, W.H.O approved liquid.ORS / RELYTE / ELECTRAL / ORS Readymix. How can Dengue be prevented?

AVOID MOSQUITO BITE as far as possible by applying repellent lotion /cream / spray / band /sticker,... Use mosquito net / bat / mosquito repellent gel tray / liquid / matt. Covering water containers should be encouraged. Keep your Environmental clean, Nothing to panic since Dengue fever is like any other Viral fever with mortality of 1%, Very less than Pneumonia (most

dangerous), MEASLES, Diarrhoea, Typhoid, Japanese encephalitis, Hib Brain fever, Hepatitis A,B (All of those are Vaccine preventable) So make sure that your kids receive vaccination for all of the above)

DURING FEVER: Do's Close monitoring of hourly temperature, Vital signs BP, Pulse, liquid intake & urine output are important especially when fever goes beyond 3 to 7days and if fever recurs within 30 days. As a First aid Please do give tepid-sponging or set AC at 25°¢ in order to cool and bring down the body temperature, Give Paracetamol as prescribed every 4 to 6th hourly also Nilavembu kudineer, and Plenty of Fluids, Fresh juices, Soups, Normal Food & ORS till you consult the Doctor Please give a spoon once in 5 minutes of W.H.O approved ORS liquid OR PEDIALYTE OR ELECTRAL OR ORS READY-MIX to prevent most important Dehydration,...

To prevent Fever: AVOID MOSQUITO BITES, DRINK BOILED & Cooled water adequately Consume Home made favourite drinks, foods after washing the hands and plates in drinking water.

DURING FEVER: Don'ts Avoid going to quacks, Avoid injections in muscles during fever, Avoid over the counter or self medications. Single injection in the muscle won't cure any fever in fact injection will harm the muscle & nerve... Avoid water storage without covering, prevent mosquito breeding to prevent Dengue fever,. Good Nutritional Status is the Shield to Combat Complications of Dengue To Keep your Environment Clean & Friendly Its each one of our Responsibility.


